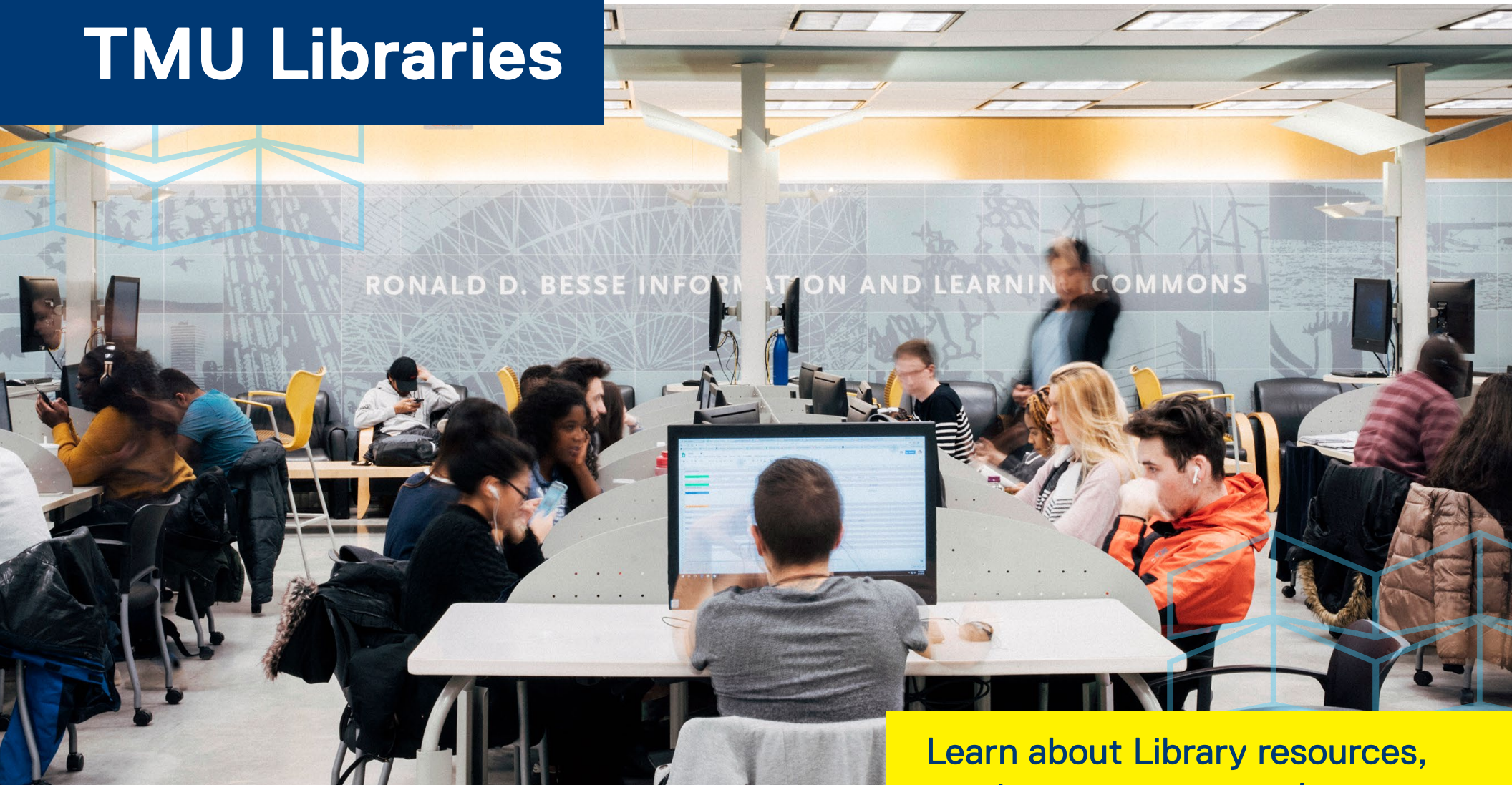

Borrowing and Lending Services

Electronic resources

At TMU Libraries you have access to millions of electronic resources (articles, ebooks, data, video) 24/7. Explore newspapers (New York Times, Toronto Star), magazines (The New Yorker), documentaries, feature films, performances, or find statistical information with full access to Statista, and more.

Interlibrary loan

Textbooks
